RAPID COVID-19 TESTING

At RigUp, we've always been about putting our workers first. In light of the COVID-19 outbreak, that means doubling down on our commitment to the health and safety of our workforce.

That's why we're launching a new pilot program, in partnership with Houston-based digital health organization imaware™, providing free access to digital COVID-19 screenings to workers on our most densely populated job sites in Texas. The pilot will begin at select job sites in Texas, with the hopes of expanding the offering to our workforce nationwide in the coming weeks.

RigUp is partnering with digital health organization imaware™ to launch rapid COVID-19 testing for its energy workforce



HOW IT WORKS

1

Eligible RigUp workers will be able to take an online assessment through our partner imaware™ to determine any risk or symptoms. The test is **voluntary** and is primarily a benefit to workers concerned about potential symptoms or exposure.

2

Workers who are classified as "at risk" will have the opportunity to work with our partners to receive a PCR (nasal swab) test for COVID-19 administered by a licensed medical professional.

The test samples will be sent to our laboratory partners for processing. During that time, workers deemed "at risk" will be instructed to not return to work, pending the results. In most cases, our medical partners will be in touch with test results within 2-4 days of the test being administered.

Should the test come back positive, the worker will have access to a comprehensive TeleHealth program to discuss the appropriate next steps to manage the illness. If negative, the worker will receive clearance to return to work.

Program FAQs

How will RigUp prioritize access to the test?

Workers at select Texas job sites in will be the first to participate in the pilot. Our goal is to expand access to the program to our workforce nationwide in the coming weeks.

How much will the test cost?

RigUp is covering the cost of the test for its workers during the pilot phase of this program.

How will RigUp determine who is at risk?

Workers who take the online diagnostic test will be classified in one of three categories: Low, Medium, and High. imaware™ will follow up with at risk individuals for the appropriate treatment.

What is considered "high risk?"

Symptoms can include fever, cough, or shortness of breath. Other considerations include pre-existing conditions, travel history, or close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19.

I was potentially exposed to COVID-19

Please self-quarantine for 14 days, even if you don't have symptoms. Our free online diagnostic test can help determine what actions you need to take and if you're eligible for telemedicine support.

Is the test FDA/CDC approved?

We have deployed a state-wide network of health professionals to deliver an FDA-approved, home-based PCR swab test. This method is the most accurate, and is required as per CDC protocols.

How do I reduce my risk of COVID-19 exposure?

Follow [CDC](#) suggestions for protecting yourself. These include washing your hands with soap and warm water, avoiding touching your face, and minimizing close contact with others.

Will I still be paid if I require testing?

You are not eligible for pay for days you're not on site. A RigUp representative will be in touch with a full list of government benefits you'll be eligible for in the event you're unable to go to work.

Why do I have to take the assessment?

This online screening is a preventative measure to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. It is available to you at any time, whether or not you are presenting symptoms or if your symptoms change.
